Minutes Of the meeting held 13th November 2017, notes taken by Cllr. Mrs. Williams.

135/17 Apologies for absence were received from Cllr. Inns due to illness.

136/17 Declarations of Interests; were received from Cllr. Daly who is a member of the PPFA.

137/17 Public participation; Mr Ackroyd and Mr. Parker from Lower Treluswell asked the PC whether someone from Cornwall Council could let the residents know of important dates and info, with regard to the suggested Student village at Penvose.

Cllr Daly informed them that the matter would be going to Committee sometime in December.

It was noted that the developers had not made the 3d plan available for public viewing, as promised.

Mr Ackroyd brought a plan of the new roundabout at Treluswell showing speed restrictions of 60mph through the roundabout.

Councillor Daly objected to the tone of the conversation.

The garage at Treluswell has complained about the width and depth of the trough at the road entrance to the garage.

138/17 To sign as a true and correct record the minutes of the meeting held 9th October.

Proposed by Cllr. Beckett seconded by Cllr. Trewern the vote was unanimous.

139/17 Matters arising;

The repairs to the lights, Cllr. Daly felt this was a matter for the Finance Committee to discuss also, and there were some queries as to the cost being covered by Service charges.

It was agreed that the light at Higher terrace needs replacing due to safety reasons, also the lights at Chapel Hill and Trelawney Road to be repaired however others to be discussed at a future date.

140/17 Commons lane; it was decided the Council should seek some legal advice as to ownership and revisit this matter.

141/17 Update from Cllr. Daly on the road crossing; Cllr. Daly brought the feasibility study (paid for by Cornwall Council) Highways have suggested splitting the scheme into two ie Crossing and Walkway.

Speed bumps in Park Road have been authorised.

After much discussion it was decided that Cllr. Daly would draft a letter to Cornwall Council regarding this project.

142/17 Report from Cornwall Councillor Mr. Williams;

The white lines at Lower Treluswell are scheduled to be done possibly by the end of December but he will keep an eye on this and follow up if necessary.

Cllr. Williams confirmed the paperwork had gone to the clerk for a grant towards the cost of a commemorative seat, in memory of Cllr. Colin Smith.

Re the suggested student village at Penvose Cllr Williams confirmed that there is a meeting at County Hall at which the Parish Council can speak.

143/17 Neighbourhood Plan Meeting the next date is 28th November at the Community Hall Café.

145/17 Planning applications;

PA17/09474 Mr Kearsley

The original application was deemed to be too large a structure. However with the new application the Council still has no objections.

PA17/025848 Mrs Bracken.

The Council reiterated that the same objections as with the original application, still apply, and the Parish Council do not support this application.

PA16/11983 Student Village.

This was denied outline permission which is available to view. 21 days from 8th Nov is the deadline for comments. The PC to hold a special meeting on the 22nd Nov at 2pm, to discuss the matter.

146/17 Authorisation of payments due;

A grant of £296 for Christmas Lights was accepted by the Council.

Proposed by Cllr Trewern seconded by Cllr Daly the vote was unanimous.

A grant application for street games of £1,065 was deferred to the next meeting to allow Cllr Daly to bring financial figures to the meeting
