Minutes of the meeting held 8th January at the New Community Hall, Ponsanooth.

**001/18 Present were; The Chairman Cllr. Mrs. M. Ferris, The Vice Chairman Cllr. Mrs. E. Williams, Cllr. C. Daly, Cllr. C. Trewern, Cllr. M. Beckett and Cornwall Councillor Mr. Peter Williams.
Also present was Mr. Parker from Lower Treluswell.**

**002/18 Apologies for absence were received from Cllr. Mrs. Manetta.
Also absent was Cllr. S. Carlyon.**

003/18 Declarations of interests were received from Cllr. Daly who is a member of the PFFA and a Planning Officer at Cornwall Council.

**004/17 Public participation;
Mr Parker informed the Council he had seen the Strategic Planning Committee broadcast regarding Penvose Student Village. Mr Parker said he was horrified at what he had seen, the fact that two gentlemen at this meeting had quoted supporting views on the application but there was no mention of objections. Mr Parker felt the letters of support were a public relations instigated response and as yet we have not had a reply to the questions put before Mr Dawes regarding this proposal. It was shown the planning people did not even know the class of the land they were discussing. Mr Parker was pleased however, that discussions have been held until February.**

The clerk was requested to contact the Qwest Briton and the Falmouth Packet regarding their article on this subject and in

which they stated that this proposal was within the remit of Penryn and Falmouth, this should be corrected, it is not in their remit it is within the remit of St Gluvias Parish Council.

There were in fact twenty two reasons against this proposal and only nine in favour, this should be the consideration of Cornwall Council.

The Parish Council to call an extra meeting on the 19th of this month to discuss this matter in depth.

Cllr. Williams and the Parish Council assured Mr. Parker this matter will not be left it will be pursued.

Cornwall Councillor Mr. Williams gave a brief suggestion of the boundary review to be forwarded by Cornwall Council however it has not been forwarded as yet to the Boundary Commission.

Cllr. Williams informed the council he would get the details and forward them to the clerk for the Parish Council to view.
