*** Cllr. Mrs. Ferris thanked Cllr. Daly, on behalf of the Council, for all the hard work which went into, the Councils ideas put forward to the Community Network Meeting**

*** Commons Lane, there are still issues surrounding ownership of this land.**

*** Cllr. Peter Williams informed the Council there would be a meeting Friday regarding Treluswell roundabout, which he feels should be maintenance free as much as possible, funding all agreed.**

*** Cllr. Trewern informed the Council that the first noticeboard has been ordered, and someone has been suggested to erect it. Cllr. Trewern to pay the costs, cheque written, waiting in cheque book to reimburse him.**

*** Cllr. Daly informed the Council that the manhole on the playing field, has been located, it happens that the 2nd application was unnecessary, and therefore a letter of complaint will be sent to SWW**
