Minutes of the meeting held 8th October 2018 at the Community Hall, Ponsanooth.

94/18 Present were; Chairman Cllr. Mrs. M. Ferris, Vice Chairman Cllr. Mrs. E. Williams, Cllr. Mrs. M. Manetta, Cllr. C. Daly, Cllr. M. Beckett, Cllr. C. Trewern, Cllr. S., Carlyon and Cornwall Councillor Mr. Peter Williams.

95/18 Declarations of Interests were received from Cllr Daly as he is a member of the PPFa and a Cornwall Council Planning Officer.

96/18 Public Participation;

Mr, Parker from Lower Treluswell informed the council that residents are still inflicted with excessive road noise, he is aware resurfacing and white lining is on the schedule to be done but wanted to make the council aware. The road from the main road up past Mr. Parkers has been resurfaced in small areas leaving skid patches.

Another lady present said she had grave concerns about the actual turning from the main road, which is an accident waiting to happen. The lady also confirmed the noise which is impacting on residents she has spoken to.

Cllr. Peter Williams said he would forward the information however as he has said resurfacing and white lines to be done on next years schedule, but he would inform the department about the turning concerns.

Mr Parker continued with the subject of the Student Village at Penvose and the effect on the drainage is a grave concern, after much information and concerns from Mr. Parker,

Cllr. Peter Williams informed the Council he would not make any comment on this subject.

The Council said they would take on board Mr Parkers concerns.

At this point Mr. Parker left the meeting.

Also present were Mr and Mrs Kingsley and supporters, who wished to inform the Council of their plans regarding the planning application before the Council at a later point. After in depth description of their intentions and reasons.

The Council confirmed this is a family business within the village, there would be no increase in traffic onto the highway and on exiting the business the ' no right turn' would continue to apply as it has done for years. More signage could be added to ensure continued safety,

Members of the public left the meeting.
