No this will be run by a private management company like the schemes in Penzance and St Ives.</p> <p>Q8 - Is the S106 legal agreement relating to transport? PB asked if this question could be put in writing.</p> <p>Q9 – CC Peter Williams asked if the highways scheme was approved as the congestion with the multiple roundabouts would have a devastating impact on the A39. PB confirmed that highways found no grounds to object to the scheme.</p> <p>Q10 – Have South West Water commented on the impact of the scheme on the current sewage system. SWW cannot formally object due to legislation and the developer needs to bear the cost of the upgrade to the system.</p>
