059/21	The Chairman Cllr Ferris welcomed everyone.	
060/21	Ruth Gripper introduced herself and as a candidate standing for election for Cornwall County Councillor for Mylor, Perranarworthal and Ponsanooth.	
061/21	There were no apologies	
062/21	There were no declarations of interest.	
063/21	The date of the April meeting has been moved to the 19 th of April 2021	
064/21	The minutes of the meeting held on the 8 th February 2021 were signed by the Chairman as a true and correct record, proposed Cllr D Willcocks, Cllr C Trewern. All Agreed.	
065/21	C Cllr P Williams confirmed reported to the meeting the Coastline Housing grant was successful for the Parish and is £750. C Cllr Williams has kindly donated a palm tree to replace the tree that has died on Treluswell roundabout. Road maintenance is ongoing and includes ditch cleaning emptying drains and line painting. He also confirmed he can check the frequency of the road sweeping schedule with the view to extending it. Cllr M Ferris reported that the History group in are keen to apply for some funding C Cllr Peter Williams.	
066/21	It was agreed to use the £750 coastline housing grant towards the picnic bench and football nets with the remaining fund to go to the streetlight replacements. Proposed Cllr Willcocks, seconded Cllr Daly.	
067/21	The PPFA have agreed to take on the management of Trevonnen Road Play Area. The Clerk confirmed that some residents from Trevonnen Road have come forward to support developing ideas for the area.	
068/21	Cllr C Daly reported that the PPFA fair Date is set for the 4 th September 2021	
069/21	It was proposed that £1752 from the Solar panel community fund to be used to match fund feasibility work for restoration of the Methodist Chapel into a community building. Power to spend is S137. Proposed Cllr M Ferris seconded Cllr E Williams.	
070/21	The Clerk shared the report on temporary cover for the Maintenance of the Parish; highlighting costs and frequency of works. The new contract is now in place and due to start on the 1 st April 2021.	
071/21	Planning Application PA21/01252 – Cosawes Park, was discussed. Members supported the application; they are also keen to develop a relationship with the applicant.	

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072/21	Planning application PA20/07393- Laity Farm, a protocol notice was discussed. Members resolved to respond to disagree with the planning officers 5 day protocol notice planning application.	
073/21	PA20/02782 Penvose Student Village. Members confirmed they had seen the communication form the case officer. It was agreed to reply thanking them for the communication. The Clerk confirmed that the applicant had been in touch and that a further email was due.	
074/21	Members received a report on the Local maintenance Partnership for 2020-21 and feedback on the Contractor cutting the footpaths. It was proposed by Cllr D Willcocks to accept the grant funding for 2021-22 and continue to maintain the Parish Footpaths. Seconded Cllr C Daly. Reports of and feedback of the contractor's work were positive, and all agreed to continue with the contractor.

078/21	Cllr S Carlyon shared further concerns over the parking problems at Kennal Vale Woods. Cllr M Ferris, C Daly and D Willcocks are to hold a meeting next week and will report back to members at the next meeting.
