


Highway maintenance and improvement scheme • November 2021

Ponsanooth civil engineering works

As part of our planned safety scheme improvements, traffic management will be in place along St Michaels Road in Ponsanooth from **Monday 8 November to Friday 10 December** while civil engineering works take place. Works will be undertaken between the hours of **8.00am and 5.00pm, Monday to Friday**.

From **Monday 6 December to Friday 10 December** overnight road closures will be in place to allow surfacing and routine maintenance activities to be carried out. These works will be undertaken between the hours of **8.30pm and 6.00am** to minimise disruption. We will have marshals on site to support residents and businesses needing local access during this time. All through traffic will need to follow the diversions in place at all times.

What works are taking place?

Our work will involve the planned delivery of a highways safety scheme to improve the safety of road users and pedestrians. This includes the installation of a new bus stop, puffin crossing, and vehicle activated signs.


Works will be carried out throughout the day under two-way traffic lights which will be manually controlled during peak traffic times and removed at night, where it is safe to do so.

There will also be an overnight road closure on the A393 from 6 to 10 December in order to complete resurfacing works with new anti-skid and carry out maintenance works in this location.

We are aiming to carry out a large amount of routine maintenance works within this closure to deliver all our planned activities one go. Increasing the scope of the highway schemes and combining them, we are making every effort to reduce the impact to the local and surrounding communities, removing the need for return visits.

Diversions

Signs will be placed at major junctions prior to the closures on the key routes to take non-through traffic away and keep traffic disruption to a minimum.



Access arrangements

Access for residents and business will be maintained through gateways managed by traffic management marshals. Residents will need to stop at the closure gateways and will be given safety instructions prior to entering the closure.

We will always do our best to accommodate day-to-day requirements of people affected by our works, and access will be maintained as much as possible for those people directly impacted by the overnight closures.

Emergency access will be maintained at all times.

Working safely

Please be aware of the following hazards while the resurfacing works take place.

- Uneven road surface where the old surface has been removed
- Raised manholes, gullies, and other service boxes
- Temporary storage of machinery and materials

We would also encourage drivers to keep to the speed limits and follow appropriate signage to ensure the safety of those working on site and fellow road users.

Notifications

Please be aware this information is correct at the time of circulation but is subject to change at short notice, especially in periods of poor weather.

If this situation arises it may result in works being postponed at short notice and we will do our best to update the advance notice boards on the site.
