165/ 23	The Chairman welcomed everyone to the meeting.	
166/ 23	There were apologies from Cllr C Daly, Cllr H Davies and Cllr D Willcocks.	
167/ 23	No declarations of interest were received	
168/ 23	The minutes of the full Council meeting held on the 10 th July 2023 were signed as a true and correct record by the Chairman Cllr M Ferris. Cllr All agreed	
169/ 23	Public participation: 3 objectors spoke of the planning application PA23/04936 on poor house hill. Concerns were raised over the applicant ignoring original planning advise in 2021, and the disregard for the community and environment by proceeding without planning permission.

175/ 23	It was resolved to submit a Tree protection Order to Cornwall Council for Penvose Farm, the Clerk confirmed the draft application, and all agreed to proceed.	
176/ 23	There was a discussion around the purpose of Commons lane, as a concern was raised about the impact of any improvements to Commons Lane. It was resolved that a further quote for the works is needed to ensure value for money. It was noted that appropriate signage should be explored to protect pedestrian users.	MG
