179/22	Declarations of interest were received from the Clerk under item 23, Penvose planning application PA19/04825	
180/22	Minutes 161/22 and 165/22 were amended by the Chairman who then signed the minutes of the meeting held on the 13 th June 2022 as a true and correct record, proposed Cllr M Beckett, seconded Cllr H Davies, all agreed.	
181/22	Public participation. Cllr H Davies reported that some parents have approached her regarding refusal for children's parties at Ponsanooth Hall. Members confirmed that the Parish Council do not manage the hall and that Ponsanooth Hall Management Committee need approaching. The Clerk confirmed she is able to find out more and bring to the next meeting.	MG
182/22	Nikki Udy from the Social Prescribing project sent her apologies for today's meeting.	
183/22	<p>Members considered planning application PA22/05772 and a number of concerns were raised</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The unsafe pedestrian access arrangements from this site is obvious enough from a visit to the area, and the lack of safe pedestrian access for these road conditions has been referred in previous Appeal decisions that dismissed proposals here. Members found it incredible that the Council's Highways Officer raised no objections to the PA20 application and question whether they had properly researched the planning history of the site. • There are likely to be issues with sewerage disposal noting that there is a package treatment included in the application although the main public sewer is only a few metres away. We understood that planning policy requires new developments to be located to the public sewer wherever practicable. A package treatment plant in the flood zone next to the river was considered to be environmentally unsafe from inundation. • The site is located in close proximity to former mine workings which do not seem to feature in the planning application. • There are concerns regarding the protection of trees which form an important part of the landscape beauty in this historic valley. • Note the houses are located outside the flood zone although most of the gardens are included within the flood zone and question whether that is an appropriate use of land. • Overall, it was considered 4 houses was an overdevelopment of this site given the planning issues in this location. <p>Proposed Cllr C Daly, seconded Cllr D Willcocks, all agreed.</p>
