Rising costs to maintain a closed building means the church is now putting the church up for sale. • The Chapel group meeting agreed not to proceed with feasibility, and share any feasibility information carried out so far to help the church find a use for the building. • Old church yard- Parish Council accepted maintenance of the old church yard, but not the boundary wall. • New cemetery – Burial authority would involve record keeping, but this liability not yet accepted. • At the meeting with the Church and Chapel Group a joint statement to protect the church was offered from the Parish Council. Information can be added to the particulars of the sale.
